



# DOMAINE D'ARGENSON



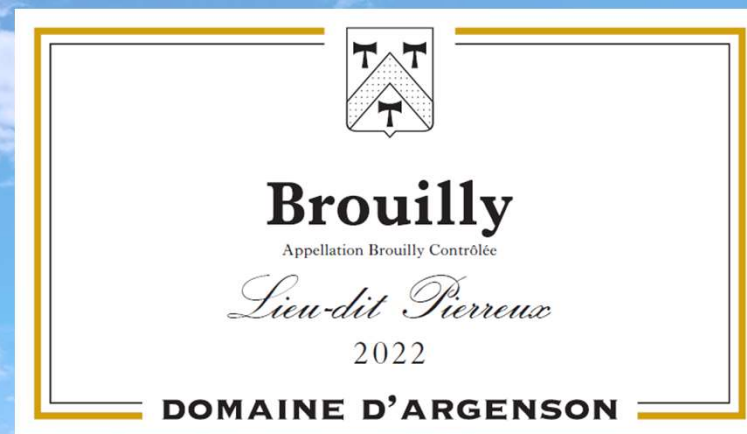
1.5 hectare plot, almost flat, with Mont Brouilly as a background.



Fifty-year-old feet, cut exclusively into goblet shapes.



Characterized by foothill soils, sedimentary rocks, and mixing sand and granite.



Single-plot cuvée from one of the best terroirs of Brouilly.  
Manual harvest and whole bunch vinification.  
To the eye: deep ruby color.  
On the nose: aromas of black fruits and sweet spices.  
In the mouth: supple attack, melted tannins, long and silky palate; candied plums on the finish.
