Plots of 5 hectares, going from the bottom of the hill to the summit of Mont.




Old vines, sometimes centuries old, only pruned into goblet shapes.

To the eye: garnet color, with purplish reflections On the nose: Scents of black fruits, pepper, and floral (violet).

In the mouth: Fresh and invigorating attack and classy, cherry on the palate; sustained finish with a beautiful tannic structure.
